



1. Who should register as an E-filer in ACCESS?

Answer: A party that is an Interested Party according to Section 771(9) of the Tariff Act of 1930, as amended (19 U.S.C. § 1677(9)), may register in ACCESS and submit documents on the record of the proceeding.

E-Filers can perform the following functions in ACCESS:

- E-File documents.
- Search for and view Public Documents and Public Versions.
- Lead attorneys and their Proxies who are included on APO service lists can access BPI Documents released by DOC.

2. Who should register as a Guest user in ACCESS?

Answer: Anyone who would like to view Public Documents and Public Versions in ACCESS.

Guest users can perform the following function in ACCESS:

- Search for and view Public Documents and Public Versions.
